APECS Romania was founded in 2013 February 22, Cryosphere conference edition I, in Piatra Neamt. Since then it has also performed an annual meeting in January 2014 in Bucharest - Faculty of Geography, and in September 2015 will be it Cluj Napoca.

Corina Itcus member APECS Romania, participated to the ROICE 2015 expedition in Antarctic King Sejong Antarctic Station (King George Island in western Antarctica) in collaboration with the Korean Institute for Polar Research. It was the first Romanian Antarctic scientific expedition.

A mentor - Cristian Lascu was part of the team that made the documentary called The Explorer, about Emil Racovita's life, following in the footsteps of his and Belgica Expedition in Antarctica.

During this time they also made ice caves explorations of Romanian Carpathians.
