



# 2017 Early Career Travel Grant Opportunity

The U.S. Permafrost Association is offering travel grants for U.S.-based students and post-graduate researchers (within 6 years of their degree) to attend conferences, field schools, or to pursue field studies relevant to permafrost science or engineering in 2017. The value of awards will be based on the merit of successful applications (\$500 minimum to \$1,500 maximum). For conferences, the applicant must be first author on a permafrost-related research presentation.

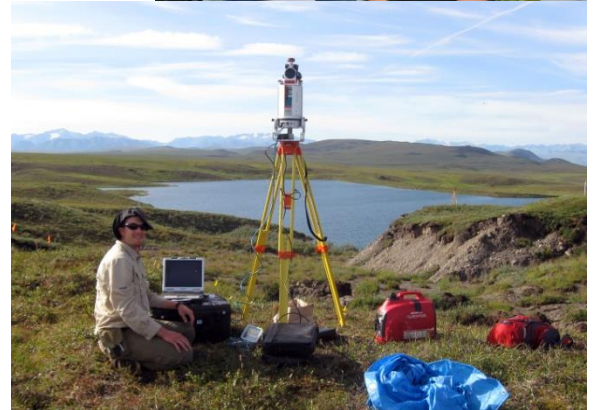
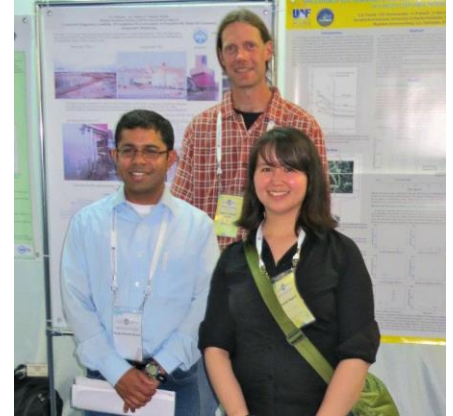
Preference will be given to applicants who are current members of both USPA and the Permafrost Young Researchers Network (PYRN).
